

RECIPE FOR THE WATERSTORIES BOTTLE

Description

The act of gifting water,
wrapped in a story,
can weave a precious web
of shared connections
to our planet

Ingredients

- 1 glass or plastic bottle 0,5L
- 1 water from a river, lake, a retention basin, the sea 0,5L
- 1 piece of paper pens, glue, scissors

Preparation

1 Prepare the Bottle

- Material: Take a clean glass or plastic bottle
- Fill it: Fill it with water. If you have a special water mix, you can use that too
- Seal: Close the bottle tightly



2 Create a fancy name for the Water

Think of an unique, meaningful name for the water.
Let it reflect something personal or spiritual



3 Design the Label

On the label, draw something that connects you to the water body.




4 Write the Back Label

On the back, write the ingredients of your water and include your name

5 Write a Letter

Write a letter that describes your connection with the water body or you wish for water and the planet.



6 Find a Waterbody and Pass it On.

- Bring the bottle and letter to another water body that holds significance to you.
- Find people who care about the water or the environment.
- Read your letter aloud to them.
- Gift the bottle, and ask them to fill another one with water from that new location, write their own letter, and pass it forward.



7 Spread the Stories

Ask the person who receives the bottle to share the story and bring it to others. Let the cycle of water + stories continue.
